Freedom to worship

In the First Reading, God has just freed the Israelites from slavery in Egypt and now He gives Moses the Ten Commandments. God gave us the Commandments to teach us true freedom and genuine love, so that we can be truly happy. Following these really means loving what God loves.

"I am the Lord your God, you shall have no gods except me" is the first commandment. We all have something that is first place in our lives. This commandment is the most important because it means recognising the truth that God really is the God of our lives and so He needs to be first place.

In the Gospel, Jesus goes into the temple. This is the place to worship and be close to God. But He sees that it has turned into a marketplace. Jesus gets angry and drives them out. The people have forgotten to put God in first place and their worship and relationship with God is a bit shaky. Jesus restores the temple to its purpose.

We have all seen the Trócaire boxes we get during Lent. Do you use them? Why do we get them during Lent?



Lent is a time of prayer, fasting and almsgiving. Almsgiving means giving to others especially the poor. The church asks us to give as an act of love to others who are in need.
